- Introductions...Welcome John Schuttinger to the JLMC
- Universal Precautions will be on every monthly agenda
- Compliance issues: Attorney Dean Eggert spoke to admin where a wide variety of subjects were covered including compliance, and the presentation was taped.
 Porter has distributed a copy to all admin
- Monica Panait from Primex stated they have free videos on blood-borne pathogens, universal precautions, bullying prevention, etc. NH Primex also has on-line trainings and courses and can provide the district with certificates of completion to verify participation
- Every staff member MUST be signed off
- Backpacks, buckets and universal precaution protection. AMS, C/W, and MVVS
 have them on site. Souhegan HS does not keep them on site. Questions as to their
 effectiveness if needed in emergency
- October 29, at AMS will be Incident Command Training with police and admin from SAU 39, all day
- MSDS Jim Miner reports companies are less and less willing to provide them
- Monica suggested we could demand them in contracts
- Emergency procedures for substitutes: evacuation and emergency plans need to be available. The Department of Labor has all building plans but the state does not require them to be under a safety plan.
- Facility Audits: Week before winter recess makes sense. Reports due for February 9th meeting of JLMC
- Buildings must verify compliance after mitigation of concerns. Should be in writing!
 Important...if a problem is identified, actions to mitigate MUST be verified. SAU
 39 will produce a boilerplate document to assure this follow-up and compliance
- Enterovirus D68 (EV-D68) Update, FAQs and information distributed. Check with Health and Human services with questions.
- Monica highlighted our most recent injury report from Primex
- John Young briefly presented an enhancement to security called Raptor that scans all licenses and ID's for child molesters and criminals when they enter the school.
 SHS is considering implementation.
