Please use the side entrance on Elm Street after 5:00 PM. Metered parking is available on the street and in the Maple Street Parking Lot. Handicapped parking is located next to the building on Elm Street.

## **Immunization Clinic:**

- All childhood immunizations are available for children 18 years and younger. A parent or legal guardian must accompany minors under age 18.
- Immunizations are available to adults over the age of 18 who have NO insurance or are underinsured, which means you have health insurance, but the coverage does not include vaccines or the insurance only covers selected vaccines.
- Please bring in Immunization Records if available.
- Vaccines available: chickenpox, meningitis, polio, Hepatitis A, Hepatitis B, flu, shingles, rotavirus, pneumococcal, tetanus, measles, mumps, rubella, diphtheria, HPV, Hib.
- A fee of \$10.00 is requested at the time of service, per person, per visit. Cash or check accepted.
- Vaccines are provided by the State of NH, Department of Health and Human Services Immunization Program and the City of Nashua.
- TB Skin Testing is now available at NO COST during Immunization Clinics, while resources are available. Please call the Nashua Community Health Department for more information.

#### Flu Vaccines:

- Flu vaccines are available for free for children 18 years and younger.
- Flu vaccines are available for all adults 19 years and older for \$15.00 regardless of insurance.
- Adults with Medicare have no out-of-pocket expense for the flu vaccine but you must bring your Medicare card at the time of the visit so Medicare can be billed.

## **Shingles Vaccine for Adults:**

- Provided to adults 60 years or older who have NO insurance that covers the vaccine either in full or in part. Please call your insurance providers, Medicare, and any supplemental insurance to determine your coverage prior to coming to the clinic. We are not able to call your insurance company for you.
- <u>Call (603) 589-4500 in advance</u> to confirm availability of the vaccine and that you meet the eligibility requirements.
- There is a \$10 administration fee.

No one will be turned away due to an inability to pay.

#### STD/HIV/HCV Clinic:

- Tests are available for HIV, Hepatitis C, herpes, gonorrhea, chlamydia and syphilis.
- A Nurse Practitioner is available during the clinic hours.
- Fees may apply. For questions, call (603) 589-4500.
