NH Data Privacy Law

As of June 2019, all NH school districts must comply with a Data Privacy Law (RSA 189:66) which concerns the protection of Student Data.

All software applications and tools that collect or house student personally identifiable information must be approved and a Data Privacy Agreement must be in place.



Student Personally Identifiable Information

Any information that is descriptive of a student or otherwise identifies a student, including, but not limited to:

- student's email
- first and or last name
- home address
- date of birth
- telephone number
- unique pupil identifier
- test results
- grades
- photos
- voice recordings

- student's educational record
- social security number
- discipline records
- special education data
- medical records
- health records
- socioeconomic information
- food purchases
- search activity
