

Do I need a Data Privacy Agreement (DPA)?

- 1. Are students signing into the application?
- 2. Is student personally identifiable information (*see box below*) or student work being uploaded or created in the application?

If you answered yes to either of the above, a DPA is needed.

How do I check to see if there is already a DPA in place?

What is Student Personally Identifiable Information (PII)?

Any information that is descriptive of a student or otherwise identifies a student, including, but not limited to:

- student's email
- first and or last name
- home address
- date of birth
- telephone number
- unique pupil identifier
- test results
- grades
- photos
- voice recordings

- student's educational record
- social security number
- discipline records
- special education data
- medical records
- health records
- socioeconomic information
- food purchases
- search activity
