Amherst School District Ways and Means Committee Meeting

Summary

At the April 29th Amherst School Board meeting, the board voted to intend to reduce the budget at the Deliberative Session on May 4th by \$144,800, all from technology line items. The official vote to reduce can only happen at the Deliberative Session.

This would make the new proposed budget \$30,429,864, which is 4.98% over last year's budget, and .99% over the FY22 default budget.

The Committee voted 3-1 to support the budget, with the intended reductions being made. There are 2 members that did not attend this meeting, and still need to vote. If the anticipated changes are not made, and/or other changes are made at the Deliberative Session, Way and Means will reconvene to discuss the budget again.

Comments on the budget

- The proposed budget being less than 1% over the default is a good number according to some members of the committee.
- The board is really trying to make cuts, but more need to be made in light of the increases (for example, the NH Retirement contributions).
- Would've liked to have seen something besides technology cut.
- Would like to see the 5th grade start the 1-1 technology program, but it won 't happen his year with cuts to technology.

The Committee may need a new chair next year, as the current chair (Ms. Parisi) is running for a position on the Amherst School Board. Anyone interested should let Ms. Parisi know. Also, the Committee is still in need of members. If anyone knows of someone that is interested in serving, let Ms. Parisi or Nate Jensen (ASD Moderator) know.

Deliberative Session Information

The Amherst School Board Deliberative Session will be held on May 4th, in-person at Souhegan High School, and via Zoom. In order to participate in the session, one must attend in-person. There will be a satellite room for those that prefer to be masked, and with others that are masked. The main room (auditorium) will be a mask optional room. It was noted that the other Deliberative Sessions taking place in town (SCSB, MVSB, and the Town of Amherst) will utilize a satellite room for those that do not wish to be masked, and the main room will require masks.

Ms. Parisi asked Ms. Schmidt to finalize the list of items to discuss with administration within the next month.
