Mission Statement

The Amherst School District Ways & Means Committee is an appointed group of Amherst community members who are tasked to review, and provide input of the Amherst School District's budget, prior to the budget being presented to the voters.

My suggested wording for the mission statement is as follows: The Amherst School District Ways & Means Committee is a group of community members who are appointed to objectively review and comment on the school budget and related fiscal requests while considering the needs of the schools and community it serves.

It reads slightly different than the current mission statement. My other suggestion would be for the wording directly under the W&M committee header to be removed entirely (as it is not our job to provide analysis) and replace with more of a neutral lead in.
