With safety in mind, we established a volunteer Safety Team to monitor grounds on our campuses. We have an excellent cadre of team volunteers already monitoring outside the schools, but we need more help!

We invite parents or community members to join our Safety Team. Candidates will need a background check and once results return from the State, receive a brief training to familiarize members with protocols and procedures.

Schools will provide each volunteer with a two-way radio at check-in, ID badge, and personal safety vest for easy recognition on campus.
