

SOUHEGAN HIGH SCHOOL OFF CAMPUS PRIVILEGES POLICY
PARENTAL CONSENT AND RELEASE FORM

This form applies to the 2020-2021 academic year ONLY

Dear Parent/Guardian and Student, In the best interest of the school administration, students, faculty, parents, and the Souhegan High School Board, the Community Council adopted a policy regarding off-campus privileges and responsibilities for Souhegan Students. This policy has been modified to fit the unusual and unique circumstances of the 2020-2021 school year. The amended policy states:

Beginning Monday, September 7th, off-campus privileges will be extended to students in all grades who have signed this parental form online. Students must follow the established check-out and check-in procedures as stated below:

1. When leaving campus before the end of the academic day, students will be required to complete the on-line check out form through their PowerSchool student account. Students **may not** have another person (including parent/guardian) log in to complete the check-out form on their behalf.
2. If a student returns to campus, they will be required to complete the on-line check in form through their PowerSchool student account. Students **may not** have another person (including parent/guardian) log in to complete the check-out form on their behalf.
3. The school retains the right to revoke off-campus privileges or parking privileges for students who violate the stated policy. Students who violate the substance abuse policy will have their off campus privileges revoked. School officials and/or the school SRO will help ensure consistent policy enforcement.

1. Please read this entire form. If there is anything you do not understand, do not sign the form until you are satisfied that you have obtained a complete explanation.
2. Fill in the blanks. If you have more than one child participating, complete one form per child.

Campus Privilege Policy. I further acknowledge that this release is binding upon my heirs, successors or assigns, and that I have executed this document voluntarily.
