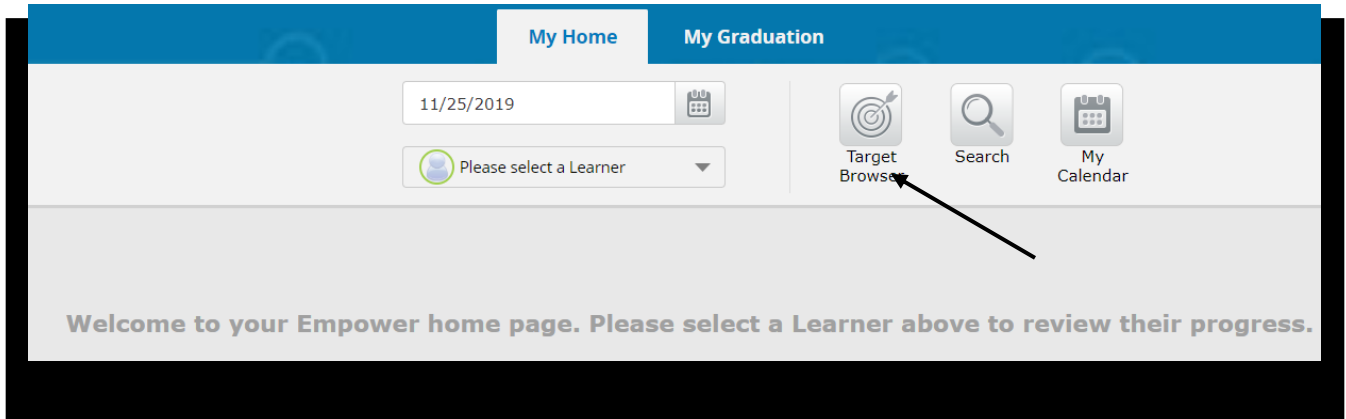


Target Browser Navigation

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- The Target Browser allows you to see every learning target/standard that your student is working on for each content area or course. It also shows you current scores for your child in each learning target/standard where they have been assessed.
- Select your child and click on “Target Browser”.



- Select Subject or Content area from the dropdown box and pick the course or grade level for your student. Scores will be visible in the lower left-hand corner of the learning target/standard. Click on the “i” icon on the learning target/standard to view information on the standard.

- The “Resources” tab will list resources used, and “My Work” will provide scored and unscored evidences used in assessing that particular learning target/standard.
